On September 21st, Yolande van den Boom (CEO MPS-Groep) presented the 500th MPS-GAP Certificate to Bert Griffioen (M.D.) of Griffioen Wassenaar.

Top Priority

Sustainability is a top priority for Griffioen Wassenaar. Bert Griffioen said "We have been MPS-A certified for years, and now we also have the MPS-GAP certificate. The perennial plants of Griffioen's perennials are grown sustainably in low-peat substrates. The pots are reused."

"Natural fertilisers in combination with so-called slow release fertilizers are used whenever possible. 100% of the plants are grown on our own nursery. That is the only way to be certain of the origin of the product."



Production Requirements

The MPS-GAP certificate is designed for companies supplying to retailers. This consists of a series of production requirements regarding traceability, sustainability, safety and hygiene. After MPS-ABC, MPS-GAP is the next step towards improved sustainability.
